Oaks at Egret Bay Information for Residents and Guests

Oaks at Egret Bay is a small community that has 23 residences. Since our neighborhood is compact it is important that we all work together to be courteous to each other. Consequently, we have some guidelines that will help us achieve that goal.

Parking: We have nine public parking spaces for guests and one space reserved for mail delivery. These spaces are for temporary guests. Residents need to park their vehicles on their own property. Service people and day visitors may park in public parking.

If a guest is staying overnight there is a form on our webpage at www.oaksegretbayhoa.com where residents can register cars for overnight parking. Cars left overnight or blocking the street are subject to towing.

Waterfront: Our waterfront is an active tidal bayou with strong currents. There are various types of wildlife in the area. Please don't feed any wildlife and please be very careful with children and pets.

Please stay away from the boats in the dock area. If you are on the upper deck, please be aware that there are boats under you.

Pets: Pets that are outside need to be kept on a leash.

Noise: Please keep noise to a minimum and no noise should be from a residence or the waterfront after 10PM.
